



This form must be completed and submitted annually to BOTH the SAWMGA Provincial Committee organizing the show AND the National Office at nationaladmin@sawmga.co.za before a stallion may participate in any SAWMGA event. No exceptions will be made.

STALLION INDEMNITY FORM 2026

1. Full Responsibility:

All SAWMGA riders and their parents/guardians are fully responsible for their horses and their horses' behavior at all times. Riders who choose to compete on a stallion accept full responsibility for the behavior of that stallion and for the safety of any person or horse that may come into contact with the stallion.

2. Mandatory Submission Before Competing:

Riders **may not compete on a stallion under any circumstances** unless this completed Stallion Indemnity Form has been submitted to **both** the National Office and the relevant Provincial body **prior to the event**. Failure to submit will result in immediate disqualification from participation.

3. Yellow Ribbon Requirement:

All stallions must wear a clearly visible **yellow tail ribbon** at all times while on the showgrounds, including during warm-up, competition, and movement between arenas. Failure to display the ribbon may result in removal from the arena or showgrounds.

4. Organizers' Authority:

Event organizers, judges, safety officials, or SAWMGA representatives reserve the full right to intervene at any time if they deem the stallion or rider to be a safety risk. This may include:

- issuing a warning,
- removing the horse from the arena,
- prohibiting further participation, or
- requesting the horse to leave the premises.

Their decision is final and will be enforced in the interest of safety.

5. Liability and Insurance:

All owners and competitors accept personal responsibility for any damages to third parties caused by themselves, their handlers, their agents, or their horses.

Riders hereby indemnify SAWMGA, its officials, and event organizers in full against any claims arising from such damages.

Riders are strongly advised to maintain valid third-party liability insurance that covers participation in all equestrian events and to ensure the policy remains current.

6. SANESA Level 0

Stallion Participation – SANESA Level 0

No child or junior rider is permitted to compete on a stallion at SANESA Level 0.

Riders who wish to compete on a stallion at any SANESA event must obtain prior written permission from the SANESA Committee before entering.
